Amrita centre for nanosciences inaugurated

KOCHI: Union Minister of State for Planning M V Rajashekharan inaugurated the first government of India funded centre for nanotechnology, 'amrita centre for nanosciences', at the Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS) here.

Addressing a gathering after inauguration, Rajashekharan said the centre for tissue engineering and stem research should explain all aspects of nanoscience in health care and energy sector.

He said the nanaoscience has immense potential to take the country on the right path of development.

"Science and technology can give solutions to all problems and is a vehicle for development process to move on," he said.

Considering the importance of science and technology in the progress of the nation, he said funds would be earmarked for its development in the 11th five-year plan.

The centre with an institute for molecular science aims to be a pioneer in tissue engineered replacements for bone, skin and cartilage which had applications in reconstructive surgery, replacement of vessels in coronary artery disease, skin replacement for burn victims and bone implants for cancer patients.

The centre will have a nano imaging laboratory, nano chemistry lab, nano chemical charaterisation lab, nano surface modification lab and


