Placement: a grand success of the CIR Department

The Corporate and International Relations (CIR) Department did a magnificent effort to place our passing out students from various streams in national and internationally acclaimed organizations. CIR is in constant touch with the corporate world to gather the latest requirements and suitably modify and fine tune the training programmes to match the requirements. CIR also organizes training programmes for the development of each and every student of Amrita Schools of Arts and Sciences in areas beyond academics, with a view to equipping them with the required skills that are indispensable in the corporate scenario. With their adorable efforts, more than 90 percent of the students were placed. The placements status upto February 2011:
