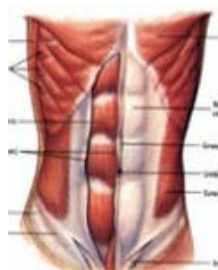

Network of four high-resolution displays

High quality delivery of video, slides

COIMBATORE: Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham has developed a multi-modal multimedia e-learning system called Amrita Virtual Interactive e-learning World (A-VIEW).

According to a release, the system uses a network of four high-resolution displays to provide a learning experience that is almost as good as a real classroom.

It has the capacity to provide simultaneously high quality delivery of video, slides, interactive whiteboard and access to latest references, all at the click of a mouse.

Bandwidth

The communication network bandwidth requirements are especially engineered to be moderate so as to permit remote sites to effectively participate.

The system works ubiquitously over the network to bring classroom teaching live from teachers at reputed institutions to students at numerous locations all over India.

Lecture

The system was launched recently at the university by Shankar Sastry, Dean, Engineering, University of California, Berkeley, the U.S. There he delivered a lecture on "What Makes a World-Class Engineering College".

Transmit

The lecture was transmitted from the university to the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bombay.

IIT, Bombay, is the first institute to adopt the A-VIEW to deliver live lectures to Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology, Nagpur.

Research

Vice-Chancellor of the university P. Venkat Rangan said: "Amrita's A-VIEW is the culmination of years of intense research and development that has brought together 20 universities in the U.S., and 50 prominent institutions in India, including Indian Space Research Organisation, Technology Information, Forecasting and Assessment Council and the Ministry of Human Resource Development's National Mission on Education."
