### Keys to houses for flood-hit people handed over to Yeddyurappa

*Mata Amritanandamayi Math constructs 100 houses for flood-hit people in Raichur district*

*Yeddyurappa grants 15 acres of land to the math for a hospital*

Bangalore: The Mata Amritanandamayi Math, which has constructed 100 houses for flood-affected people in Raichur district, handed over the symbolic key to Chief Minister B.S. Yeddyurappa at a public function near Kengeri here on Wednesday. Each house was constructed at a cost of Rs. 1.65 lakh.

Mr. Yeddyurappa announced a grant of Rs. 5 crore and 15 acres of land near Ramasandra near Kengeri to the math to construct a hospital. The price of land in Ramasandra has touched at least Rs. 3 crore an acre.

In the function organised at the Math on Ullal Main Road near Kengeri, Mata Amritananda Mayi handed over the key to the Chief Minister, which the latter handed over to the Raichur Deputy Commissioner V. Anbu Kumar.

Addressing the gathering, Mr. Yeddyurappa lauded the social service of the math and Mata Amritanandamayi.

"The math had signed an agreement with the State Government to construct 700 houses in Raichur on January 16. It constructed 100 good quality permanent houses in 20 days. Remaining houses are under construction and they will be completed shortly," he said.

The math is also planning to construct more number of houses for the
