Rules & Regulations

Applicable for Admissions to MBBS/BDS - 2019

Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, a constituent unit of the AMRITA VISHWA VIDYAPEETHAM conducts MBBS/BDS in its Health Sciences Campus at Kochi, Kerala, India. Selection for MBBS/BDS is based on the rank obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) – UG 2019 conducted by the National Testing Agency.

Important

The admission activities to MBBS/BDS are through the Admission Office presided by the Chairman – Admissions, Amrita Healthcare Campus, Kochi.

Management of the AMRITA VISHWA VIDYAPEETHAM reserves the right to change any of the conditions enumerated herein for the purpose of complying with any of the regulations of the University Grants Commission (UGC) or any other competent authorities.

Online Common Counselling conducted by DGHS (www.mcc.nic.in) after NEET results

Centralised Counselling (for General Category and NRI Category) is conducted by the Directorate General of Health Service (DGHS) / Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) / Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India, New Delhi through MCC website www.mcc.nic.in.

NEET qualified candidates are advised to visit the MCC website www.mcc.nic.in regularly for notifications, instructions, counselling scheme, counselling schedule, and other notifications. Candidates should apply / register for online counselling through www.mcc.nic.in as per the notification of DGHS. NRI Admissions are also made on the basis of the qualifying NEET – 2019 Examination.

Candidates may also visit Amrita MBBS page (<https://www.amrita.edu/admissions/mbbs-2019>) & BDS page (<https://www.amrita.edu/admissions/bds-2019>) regularly for latest notifications and updates pertaining to MBBS/BDS Admissions.

If a candidate has secured a seat in Amrita in any of the allotment rounds, then he/she is requested to report at Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi for admission procedure with relevant certificates and fees payment in the form of Demand Draft as per the schedule of reporting published in MCC website.

The allotted candidates are advised to check Amrita website (www.amrita.edu/healthsciences) for details of admission and other instructions before reporting.

Seat Category

- a) **General Category:** As per the DGHS – MCC guidelines
- b) **NRI Category:** As per the DGHS – MCC guidelines and also please refer the Supreme Court Order - W.P. (C) No.689/2017

Proxy for reporting in Amrita for admission process

Reporting for admission by proxy is not generally permitted. Admission of the allotted candidates who do not report to the Admission Office, Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi within the specified reporting schedule shall stand cancelled.

In extremely exceptional cases, where the candidate is unable to report physically due to illness for attending admission procedure, the Chairman – Admissions at his sole discretion may permit candidate's father, mother, brother or sister to attend the counselling on behalf of the candidate on the basis of a written request. Also, specific authorisation from the candidate with relevant Medical Certificate **from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon or a Clinical Associate Professor of a Medical College** should be submitted at the time of reporting for admission. However, all Original Certificates / Documents should be submitted.

Verification of Documents

- All admissions are subject to verification of the original certificates and documents of the candidates. The decision of the Chairman - Admissions regarding the eligibility of applicants shall be final.
- If at any time before or after admission it is found that the candidate does not meet the eligibility requirement, seat will be denied to him/her. Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ensure that he/she meets all the eligibility requirements.
- While reporting to Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi for admission procedure, candidates should be accompanied by their parent and should produce the following documents in original **along with two additional sets of self-attested photocopies.**

List of Original Documents to be submitted at the time of reporting :-

- Online provisional allotment letter from MCC
- NEET UG 2019 Score Card
- NEET UG 2019 Admit Card
- 12th Mark Sheet & Pass Certificate (in case of CBSE/ICSE)
- 10th Certificate or Date of Birth Certificate (if 10th Certificate does not bear the same)
- Transfer certificate from the institution last studied
- Character and conduct certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied
- Migration certificate from the school from last studied
- Copy of Aadhaar Card of the candidate
- Copy of PAN Card of the candidate (if the candidate doesn't have one, they may submit the PAN Card copy of their parents)
- Recent passport size colour photographs showing close-up of face – 4 nos
- Course fee must be paid through Demand Draft drawn in favour of - “Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham” for MBBS and “Amrita School of Dentistry” for BDS payable at Kochi/Ernakulam
- Medical Certificate for Physical Fitness & Mental Soundness from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon or a Clinical Associate Professor of a Medical College
- Physical Handicap (PH) Certificate (if applicable)
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Two copies of the all the certificates mentioned above

THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS ARE MANDATORY AT THE TIME OF REPORTING

Apart from the documents mentioned above, NRI candidates should submit other relevant NRI related documents as per MCC while reporting.

- Candidates who studied a syllabus other than CBSE/ ICSE/ Indian State Boards should procure an Equivalence Certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English studied in the final year.
- Translated version of all documents, if they are not in English

NOTE: CANDIDATES COMING FOR ADMISSIONS WITH INCOMPLETE LIST OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE & WILL BE REJECTED

Candidates admitted must remit the Annual Course fees at the time of admission itself. This initial fee payment should be made only by Demand Draft in favour of “Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham” for MBBS and “Amrita School of Dentistry” for BDS , payable at Kochi / Ernakulam drawn on any scheduled banks (as per the instructions provided in the website at the time of admission). Request of extension of time for payment of fee will not be considered. Cheques or Cash Payment will not be accepted / entertained at all.
