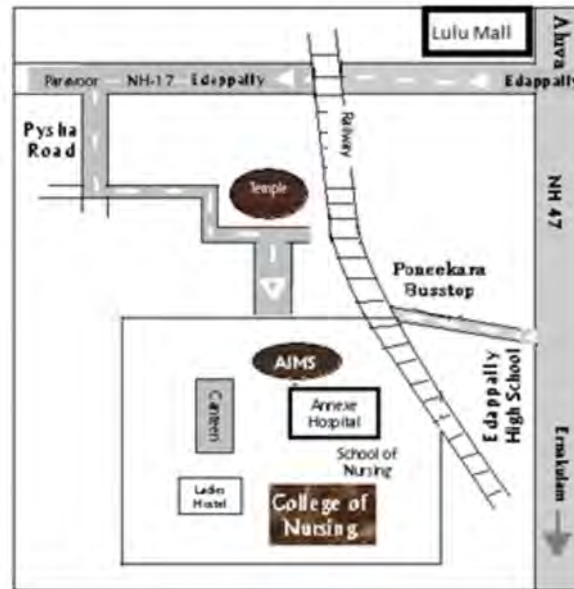

- Name of the presenting author must be underlined. Duration of oral presentation – 10 min (7 min for presentation and 3 min for discussion).

Poster size should be 4 x 3 ft or 120 x 90 cm.
