The student must take the initiative to apply for the process of awarding grace marks. First and foremost, the student must get approval from the respective competent authorities as follows:

Sports & Games: Director, Department of Physical Education (in all campuses)

Cultural Activities: Dept. of Students Welfare (CBE campus) or an equivalent organization in other campuses

Technical Competition: Dept Chairperson

Seva Activities (including NSS): Dept. of Students Welfare (CBE campus) or an equivalent organization in other campuses

The role of the competent authorities is to describe briefly the achievement, assign the activity code and endorse.

School Heads to forward a consolidated list of students and the activity code to the Controller of Examination's office for the final assignment of grace marks. Maximum allowable grace mark for each category is as indicated in Table 1.

Rules and guidelines

- 1) The grace marks shall not be shown separately in the grade card.
- 2) The maximum cumulative grace mark awarded to the students in a particular semester for all the activities such as Sports & Games, Cultural activities, Technical competition and Seva activities (including NSS) put together should not exceed 20 marks.
- 3) The grace marks awarded shall not be considered for ranking.
- 4) The grace marks shall be distributed to the best advantage of the student at the time of finalization of the results in the concerned semester.
- 5) The grace marks once distributed on the request of the student will not be reopened.
- 6) The grace marks are awarded for theory papers. However, if the grade marks are below the required minimum for a pass in viva-voce, projects and practical's, the grace marks may be used for non-theory courses.

- 7) The student shall claim the grace marks only for the semester in which the event concluded/results declared.
- 8) Grace marks can be awarded from even semester AY 2015-2016 (Jan – May 2016).
