I am to state that the General Body of this council at its meeting held on 30/03/2016 considered the Council Assessor's report (13th August, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi for purpose of Recognition of M.Ch(Urology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University, Coimbatore, Kochi, Kerala.

The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (13th August, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that M.Ch(Urology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University, Coimbatore, Kochi, Kerala in respect of students being trained at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

You are requested to issue notification recognizing the above qualification on or after August, 2012.
