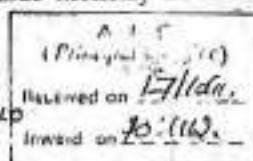

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

You are requested to issue necessary notification for recognition of the above qualification at the earliest.

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (April, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 04 seats granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University in respect of students being trained at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. 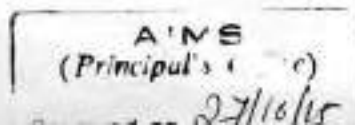
