



POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES PROSPECTUS 2014

1. Admission Policies & Procedures:

VERY IMPORTANT: Management of Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham reserves the right to change any of the conditions enumerated herein for the purpose of complying with any of the regulations of the University Grants Commission or any other competent authorities.

1. All important announcements are made in the website. NO information is sent by post or by any other means. University will take efforts to pass the information by phone in case of urgency.
2. Candidate is required to join the programme after satisfying the requirements as mentioned in the website.
3. All admissions are subject to verification of the original certificates and documents produced by the candidates. All certificates in original shall be surrendered to the university for a period of minimum one year.
4. The decision of the Chairman-Admissions regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.
5. Admitted candidates are required to pay the tuition and other fee at the time of admission by way of demand draft, as mentioned in the Admission Offer Letter.
6. From second semester onwards, fee is to be paid on semester basis. Dates are notified on the university notice boards. Those who stay in university hostels shall pay their hostel and mess fee on yearly basis.
7. Students whose residence is beyond 30 kms from the university campus shall strictly stay in the university hostel.

8. M.Tech WNA programme is strictly residential.

2. Grounds on which an admission may get rejected:

Admission offer already made is cancelled if the candidate fails to comply with the eligibility criteria at the time of admission.

3. Cancellation of admission and refund of fees

- a) If a candidate wishes to cancel the admission after all completing all the formalities, he/she has to submit a request in writing at the Admission Office, addressed to Chairman (Admissions). **Request shall duly signed by the candidate and the parent / guardian and shall be compulsorily submitted in person. No other means is entertained or considered valid.** The same shall be signed by the candidate as well as candidate's parent or the guardian. Any other type of intimation is considered unofficial.

- b) For candidates who have joined the programme but opt to discontinue before commencement of classes, fee collected is refunded after deducting Rs.1000/- towards the administrative expenses.
- c) For candidates opting to discontinue the study within a period of two weeks of commencement of classes, 80% of tuition fee is refunded, while 20% is retained as administrative charges.
- d) Admissions are closed two weeks after the commencement of classes. Students who withdraw after the closing date of admissions are not eligible for any refund of money paid as tuition fees.

18. Code of Conduct

- a) Students staying more than 30 kms away from the campus are required to stay in the university hostel.
- b) Dress code is mandatory for all the students, as prescribed in the rules of the university.
- c) Students shall strictly abide the rules and regulations, given to them at the time of joining and in the beginning of each academic year.
- d) Failure to observe discipline will attract appropriate disciplinary action.

19. Anti-ragging rules & regulations

The Supreme Court of India, UGC, Governments of Kerala and other states have recommended very stringent measures to prevent Ragging in Educational Institutions.

According to these recommendations, any student found to be guilty of involvement in any act of Ragging will be summarily dismissed from the Institution with a remark in his Transfer Certificate to that effect. Wherever necessary, the matter may also be referred to the Police.

Ragging includes tormenting others by words or deed, playing rough jokes on other, engaging in rough play, physical assault or threat, use of physical force, verbal abuse and aggression, exhibiting indecent gestures and obscene behavior, exposing fellow students and others to ridicule and contempt, violating the status, dignity, and honor of fellow students and others, violating the privacy and rights of others, and hassling or exhibiting riotous behavior. In the light of the above, as per recommendations of the Supreme Court, an annual joint declaration by the parent and the student is mandatory for the student to be enrolled for the classes.

20. Settlement of disputes

In case of any dispute in the interpretation of any of the conditions included in this booklet relating to admission to the above programmes, decision of the Admission Committee will be final and binding.

21. Jurisdiction

Courts situated in Kollam, Kerala only have the jurisdiction over disputes if any arising on the matter of applications and or admission to the course covered under this prospectus.

Amrita School of Arts & Sciences

M.Com

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 25

Eligibility: Graduation in B.Com/ BBM/ BBA/ B.Sc. Banking with a minimum of 50% marks. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

M.Sc. Physics

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 25

Graduation in Physics or Physics as main subject with an aggregate minimum of 50% marks excluding language subjects. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

M.Sc. Chemistry

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 25

Graduation in Chemistry or Chemistry as main subject, with an aggregate minimum of 50% marks excluding language subjects. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

M.Sc. Mathematics

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 25

Eligibility: Graduation in Mathematics or Mathematics as main with an aggregate minimum of 50% marks excluding language subjects. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

Master of Social Work

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 30

Eligibility: Graduation in any discipline from a recognized university. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

Amrita School of Engineering

MCA

Duration: 3 years, 6 semesters for regular stream and 2 years, 4 semesters for lateral entry stream

Seats: Regular: 60; Lateral Entry: 25

Eligibility: *Regular stream*: Three year degree scoring a minimum of 60% with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduate Level. *Lateral entry stream*: Three year degree in BCA, B.Sc. (IT/Computer Science) scoring a minimum of 60% with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduate Level.

M.Sc. Computer Science

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters; Seats: 25

Eligibility: Graduation in CS / CA / IT / SE / Physics / Mathematics with Computer Applications or BCA with an aggregate minimum of 55% marks excluding language subjects. Selection is based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and interview.

Cost & Payment: Rs.500/- can be paid either by way of NetBanking or apply online, download the printed application form and send it along with the demand draft for the above amount. The demand draft shall be in favor of "Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham" payable at "Kollam".

APPLICATION SUBMISSION & SELECTION PROCEDURE

How to Apply:

Applications submission for admission to M.Tech programmes offered at Amritapuri campus of Amrita University is fully online. Candidates are required to visit <http://am.amrita.edu/> to submit the online application. University strongly recommends reading the instructions and guidelines (available in the website) carefully before submitting the online application.

Cost of Application form: Rs. 750/-.

Candidates with valid GATE score are also required to attend test and interview. However, they are given preference.

Downloading of Admit Cards:

Admit Card is compulsory to appear for the test and interview. Admit Card shall be printed on a neat A4 page. Photo on the Admit Card shall be attested by the Principal of the institution last attended by the candidate or by a Gazetted Officer. Applicant shall produce the printed copy of the Admit Card to attend test and interview. The admission staff will mark the attendance at the reporting counter, computer lab and at the interview on the Admit Card. The same shall be retained by the candidate for surrendering at the time of admission.

Computer Based Examination: Questions, Topics, Answering pattern, Evaluation

Test and interview at Amritapuri campus is scheduled on 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th of June at Amritapuri campus. Computer Based Test is common for all the applicants. Test starts at 09:30 AM and candidates are required to report at 08:30 AM at the campus. Candidates shall bring the pen / pencil for rough work in the computer lab. Paper will be provided.

Test is of 90 (09:30 to 11:00) minute duration with 90 multiple choice questions from following topics:

1. Mathematics – 35
 - a. Quantitative – 10
 - b. Algebra – 10
 - c. Calculus – 5
 - d. Vectors – 5
 - e. Sets & Probability – 5
2. Test of reasoning: 25 (both verbal and non-verbal)
3. Programming: 10
4. English – 20
 - a. Vocabulary – 5
 - b. Reading composition – 15

Each question carries 4 marks. For each wrong answer, one mark is deducted. No reduction of mark if a question is unanswered.

Interview

Test is followed by interview on the same day. Applicant may have to stay back for one more day, if he/she has opted multiple specializations according to the eligibility. For those who have given the preference as VLSI have to attend technical test in the same day noon, instead of interview.

Rank list publication:

Rank list is published in one week of the last date of interview. Separate rank list is published for each specialization. For example, if an applicant with B.Tech Computer Science has attended interview in CSE, WNA & Cyber Security, his/her name will appear in all the three rank lists. If the name appears in the "selected" category, the applicant deserves the right to choose the specialization.

Admission Procedure: Candidates who are in the selected category shall make the partial payment of tuition & other fees on or before the date mentioned in the website. If the selected candidate fail to pay the fees on or before this date, the seat is given to the next candidate in the rank order.

Computer Based Test and Interview: Second Week of June

Publication of rank list: Within 3 days of the last date of the interview.

Option submission: Next two days of the publication of the rank list.

Commence of classes: Last week of July
