



Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham to come up in AP

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday laid the foundation stone for Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham's campus at Nowluru village.

The Mata Amritanandamayi Math is setting up the Vidyapeetham, a deemed-to-be university, with an investment of Rs 2,500 crore. It will be spread over 200 acres.

This is the third major educational institute, after SRM and the VIT, to come up in Amaravati, the new capital of AP.

"This will be our seventh campus and focus will be on research, higher education and human values," Vidyapeetham Vice-Chancellor Venkat Rangan said. PTI
