



India's first cybersecurity startup at Amrita

Kochi: Amrita University's Technology Business Incubator (TBI) and its Centre for Cybersecurity Systems and Networks (CCSN) have joined hands to set up India's first startup hub to focus exclusively on cybersecurity.
